Hello McGregor EXPLORE families!

EXPLORE is a fun way to extend our student's learning while allowing them to spend time with friends.

Explore Session 2 will begin on Thursday, July 5th, and will conclude on

Tuesday, July 31st.

We start promptly at 8:50 a.m. and end at 3:20 p.m. Doors will open at 8:35.

Both breakfast and lunch will be provided during the day at Explore.

General Information:

- We will follow the arrival and dismissal procedure currently in place at McGregor.
- Transportation for Explore will be available to specific sites for eligible elementary students. Students must register by May 15 to be guaranteed bus transportation the first day of Explore. They are eligible only if they live within the designated attendance area and their residence is more than 1.5 miles from their assigned Explore site. Students may choose to attend any Explore location if they provide their own transportation. Call 417-523-0500 for transportation questions.
- Having good attendance is extremely important during Explore. There are many activities and experiences to take part in, and we want to make sure your child doesn't miss out. Your efforts in making sure your child is here everyday is very much appreciated! If your child will be unable to attend, please call the office at 417-523-5700.
- Demonstrating good behavior is expected at all times during EXPLORE. Student misbehaviors will be addressed in a proactive manner using principles of positive behavior interventions. Explore Coordinators will review instances with students having repeated inappropriate behaviors. At the Explore Coordinators' discretion, students with repeated inappropriate behavior may be dropped from the program.
- If your child requires medication to be taken during school hours,

please contact our school nurse for the proper paperwork to be completed.

- Please make plans with your child regarding how he/she will get home prior to the beginning of the school day. Keeping a constant routine helps children feel secure during the day, so we encourage a regular pattern of school-to-home transportation. Occasionally, plans must be changed. If you have an emergency and you must arrange for alternate transportation, you may call the secretary (before 2:30) at 417-523-5700 and leave a message to be delivered to your child's teacher.
