School Based Mental Health Services

Professional School Counselors (PSC)

- Offer a full spectrum of prevention, intervention and support services to meet the social, emotional and academic needs of all students.

Each district school has one or more Professional School Counselors on staff to work with all students.

School Based Clinicians (SBC)

- Coordinate with school staff to provide the following services:
 - Consultation with school personnel to assist students and families facing crisis
 - Individual, group or family therapy for students
 - Clinical assessments and interventions for students and families
