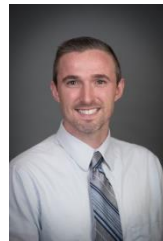
The medical mobile unit can provide services to children from newborn up to 21 years of age who are enrolled in Springfield Public Schools. The mobile unit is designed to provide services to children covered by Medicaid, and children who are non-insured. Trudi's Kids is staffed by a Nurse Practitioner who is able to assess, diagnose, and treat patients, in collaboration with a physician.
